

Living Conditions

We will stay in a home, which is not equipped with electricity or running water. The local people will cook for us. Food will be simple (beans, rice, fruit, etc). You will have a cot to sleep on. You will need to bring a sleeping bag.

Getting to the Project

We will ride in the back of a truck. We go East of Tegucigalpa, to Danli, and on East and North. The road will become a two-track trail. This is the area we have been working the past several years. The name of the village is Los Pinos.

People in the Village

The people live on the side of the mountain, among their farms. They have small mud and stick homes. The school they had was a building they built themselves. It fell down. We will replace it with a building similar to the one pictured here. It will be used for a grade school.

Our Purpose

We seek to make a difference through participation in hands-on mission activities. We go not so much to complete our task, but to share love and learn from the people.

What

This trip will be to a remote area in Honduras. The team will assist a community in building a grade school.

Where

A community is named Los Pinos. We have done projects in Honduras for the past 15 years. These are very poor people and need our help.

When

We will leave close to January 14th and return around Jan. 25th. These are approximate dates. The actual dates may be a day or two different. An itinerary will be provided, as we get closer to the departure date.

Who

We will have a maximum of 15 persons on our team. Participants must be 16 years or older. A parent or relative must accompany persons under the age of 18.

Passport

A passport is required. Apply immediately if you do not have one. Your passport needs to be valid for 6 Months from the day we leave the US.

Cost

The cost per participant is \$1,500. **\$100 deposit is due now.** The balance is due Dec. 1st, 2019. Some scholarship money may be available for "first timers". Please check with Boyd.

Project Funds

We will need approximately \$20,000 to complete the school. If we have more we will buy desks and books for the school. As a team member you will be expected to help raise funds.

Clothing

This area of Los Pinos is approximately 3,000 ft. above sea level. This will be the dry season, although there may be light rain during an evening or two. The days will be warm and the nights cool. You will need to bring a couple changes of work clothes. (We can do laundry). Bring leisure clothes for travel.

Work

The work will be hand labor, laying blocks, pouring concrete. During the afternoons we will do programs for the children. We will meet with the local people during most evenings. Team members will be expected to share their faith.
